Please note the following policies:

- Each vendor is required to donate an item or gift certificate for the Chamber's Silent Auction. Items will be picked up during set up. (Christmas in Divide is the Divide Chamber of Commerce's primary fundraiser. Silent Auction proceeds help fund the Chamber's activities and special projects, such as the Midland Depot renovation, Teller Historic and Environmental Coalition, and Summit Elementary School.)
- The entire front foyer of Summit Elementary School may be rented as a space for \$100. Please call Joe Kain at Ancestral Arts: 719-687-2278, to reserve it.
- Prices:
  - 6 foot spaces (\$30 non-member/\$20 member each)
  - 8 foot spaces (\$40 non-member/\$30 member each)
  - Tables may be rented (\$10) or you may bring your own table at no charge.
  - Electricity (\$5)
- No-shows are non-refundable.
- Set up time is from 8:00 to 9:00 am. Breakdown is at 3:00 pm. (If you breakdown before 3:00 pm, you will not be allowed to participate in future DCC vendor events.)
